

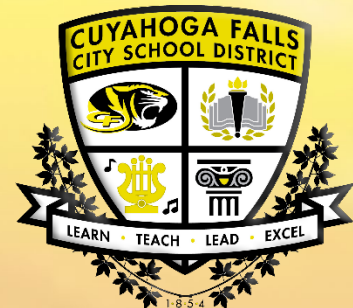

The Cuyahoga Falls Chamber of Commerce consists of businesses and individuals working together to build a healthy economy and to improve the quality of life in Cuyahoga Falls. The organization held its first meeting in the fall of 1926. During the 1960's and 1970's, the organization became actively involved with the Cuyahoga Falls City School District offering support to the district's passage of school bonds.

In 2005, the Chamber of Commerce recognized a need for a non-profit foundation that would serve the purpose of raising money to put back in the community by way of scholarships. Every year the Cuyahoga Falls Area Chamber of Commerce Foundation, Inc. awards scholarships to Cuyahoga Falls High School graduating seniors. The Foundation hopes that the scholarships will encourage the recipients to excel as future business leaders, participate in the Cuyahoga Falls Chamber of Commerce, and give back to the community.

Levy support and the annual scholarships are only two instances of Chamber member involvement in our district. More than eighty business are represented on Career Night each year at the high school. Members also participate on the Career Night Committee. Other efforts include Business Leader School Tours and the City Art Walk. Chamber CEO, Laura Petrella, and other business leaders are members of the district's Business Advisory Council and the Alliance for School and Community Growth. Members faithfully and enthusiastically attend these meetings on a monthly basis contributing insights and ideas to enhance the learning experiences of our students.
